

## Santiago Geologic Hazard Abatement District

### Typical Meeting Details

The Santiago Geologic Hazard Abatement District (GHAD) meetings will be in conformity with the Brown Act. General meeting details:

- Meetings are usually held quarterly.
- Meeting times are usually from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.
- Meetings are held in the Canyon Room at the East Anaheim Community Center, 8201 E. Santa Ana Canyon Road, Anaheim, CA 92808.
- A public forum is held at each meeting, allowing each speaker 3 to 5 minutes to talk on topics not on the agenda for that meeting. A speaker card should be filled out before the meeting.
- Meetings dates are scheduled at each meeting for the following meeting.
- Agendas for meetings are required to be posted a minimum of 72 hours prior to the meeting.
- Agendas are posted on the Santiago GHAD website ([www.santiagohad.org](http://www.santiagohad.org)) and on the lamppost labeled "59085D" near the intersection of Williams Circle and Serrano Avenue.
- If a meeting date is changed, the Clerk will notify all Boardmembers by e-mail or phone. The change will be posted on the GHAD website along with the updated agenda posted on the lamppost labeled "59085D" near the intersection of Williams Circle and Serrano Avenue.

The Santiago GHAD will do its best to comply with the general meeting details, but failure to do so, unless mandated by law, shall not be grounds for cancellation of a meeting or invalidation of action taken at the same time.
